The BRABUS 900 Crawler – or "Supercar" as the tuners from the Ruhr region have dubbed it – boasts 900 hp under its carbon hood, so no need to hide from its on-the-road competitors. The Crawler accelerates from 0 to 100 km/h in 3.4 seconds and is limited to a top speed of 160 km/h. If its tires are to survive, even on difficult terrain, they must indeed meet stringent requirements. As a 4x4 tire model developed not only for on-road use but also for off-road use, the Grabber X³ from General Tire is naturally the perfect choice here.

With its aggressive tread pattern and innovative product features, the Mud Terrain tire offers maximum durability. The tire impresses with its three main technologies: An innovative tread to ensure maximum traction in mud, an excellent grip to guarantee safety, even on loose surfaces, and an exceptional cut resistance for reliable performance, even on rocky terrain. The Grabber X³ is available in 38 different sizes for 15- to 20-inch rims.
